SUB: Proposal for the opening of a K.V. at the site
of Laturpur Thermal Power Project/station during
1981-82 under the category of project

Dear Sir,

Kindly refer to your letter No. F.1-I05/80-kVs(cc-I)
dated 25.2.1981 on the subject noted above. We have
already furnished all the requisite information and
undertakings in our previous communication no. 01:nnn:loc:sd().

All the same, to recapitulate it may be mentioned that
the National Thermal Power Corporation Ltd., a public sector
enterprise with 100% shares held by the President of India
undertakes to bear the entire cost as well as recurring and
non-recurring expenses including further development
expenses and proportionate overhead charges on the
proposed K.V. at the site of Laturpur thermal power
project/station.

The Company will also provide land, building, staff
quarters and other requisite physical facilities for
opening the proposed School.

We are endorsing a copy of this communication to the
Dept. of Power Ministry of Energy under whose
corporation is working. They will write to you directly
endorsing our request for opening of a K.V. at Laturpur.

The Board of Directors of NTPC passed a resolution on the
subject as far back as on 10th April 1979. Based on this
resolution K.V.s have already started functioning at Kharagpur
and e.f. academic year 1979-80 and at Ranagunder e.e.f.
academic year 1980-81. The remaining two schools at New
Ranagunder and at Laturpur are proposed to be started from the
academic year 1981-82 for which your approval is solicited.

Four copies of the above mentioned resolution of the
Board of Directors are enclosed (Annexure 'A'). As
regards norms laid down by KVS for opening a new K.V.
four copies of our estimates and undertakings in this
concern are enclosed (Annexure 'B').

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In regards terms and conditions, four copies of our acceptance are also enclosed (Annexure 'C').

The Survey Report in the prescribed format is enclosed in quadruplicate (Annexure 'D').

We would welcome the team of Sangathan to visit the site and see for themselves the physical facilities provided and in the process of being provided for the proposed R.V. Any further facilities desired to be provided, would be provided as per advice of Inspection Team immediately. An early action is solicited.

ANNEXURE I

TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR OPENING KENDRIYA VIDYALAYA
CAMPUSES OF PUBLIC SECTOR UNDERTAKINGS/INSTITUTIONS
OF HIGHER LEARNING:

Note: Acceptance of terms and conditions by the sponsor is a pre-condition for the opening of a Kendriya Vidyalaya Public Sector/Institution of Higher Learning. The sponsor authority is required to submit, in quadruplicate, the acceptance and confirmation of the terms and conditions enumerated below.

I. GENERAL:

- (a) The Sangathan does not take over any existing school.
- (b) It opens a new Kendriya Vidyalaya of its own with its own curriculum and pattern of education.
- (c) The Sangathan does not run KG or Pre-Primary classes.
- (d) In no case the Sangathan will take the liability of appointing/absorbing any of the staff member of existing school in the service of the Sangathan. Existing staff members may, however, apply in response to the advertisement for various categories of posts advertised by the Sangathan from time to time.

II FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS:

A new Kendriya Vidyalaya(Central School) may be open campus of a Government of India Undertaking or Institution of Higher Learning, if it agrees to bear the recurring and non-recurring expenditure, including accommodation, land and developmental facilities as also the proportionate overhead charges on the proposed Vidyalaya.

III. LAND AND BUILDING FOR THE PROPOSED KENDRIYA VIDYALAYA:

The sponsoring authority will have to provide a suitable place of land, free of cost, measuring about 15 acres on which Vidyalaya Building/Staff quarters/Hostel/Playground will be developed and constructed by the sponsoring authority of its own fund in accordance with KVS norms. In case of building-s, at least 20 rooms of such sizes as to accommodate at least 40 students per section are required. This accommodation may be sufficient for classes upto V with two sections in consequent expansion of the Kendriya Vidyalaya for 3-4. This may also include Principal's room, staff room, library, office and accommodation for other miscellaneous activities like Music, NCC, Scouting and Guiding, SUPW, etc. A sketch map indicating the size of the rooms proposed to be provided may be enclosed. Temporary accommodation once provided may be withdrawn unless K.V.S. is satisfied with alternate arrangements made in this regard by the sponsoring authority.

IV. RESIDENTIAL ACCOMMODATION:

Cent per cent residential accommodation will have to be provided on priority basis by the sponsoring authority on same terms and conditions as applicable to their own staff corresponding status.

V. ADMISSIONS:-

Admission Priorities in Kendriya Vidyalaya in
Public Sector Undertaking/Institution of
Higher Learning:

Admissions in Kendriya Vidyalayas are regulated on the sole criterion of the test of transferability of the parent i.e. the number of transfers a parent has undergone during the preceding seven years. The children of the employees who have undergone a more number of transfers during the preceding seven years will get preference over those children whose parents have undergone

V. ADMISSIONS:- Admission Priorities in Kendriya Vidyalaya in Public Sector Undertaking/Institution of Higher Learning:

Admissions in Kendriya Vidyalayas are regulated on the sole criterion of the test of transferability of the parent i.e. the number of transfers a parent has undergone during the preceding seven years. The children of the employees who have undergone a more number of transfers during the preceding seven years will get preference over those children whose parents have undergone lesser number of transfers during the same period.

II Kendriya Vidyalayas in Public Sector Undertakings.

- (a) Children of the employees of the concerned undertaking provided it meets all expenses, recurring as well as non-recurring , land, building and equipment etc.

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- b) Children of Central Government employees including Defence/CRPF/BSF personnel in uniform and employees of All-India Services and Indian Foreign Service.
 - c) Children of transferable employees of the Autonomous bodies and other Public Sector Undertakings, fully, financed by the Central Government.
 - d) Children of non-transferable Central Government employees and Defence personnel; and
 - e) Children of the other floating population which includes civilian population desirous of joining the pattern of studies adopted in Kendriya Vidyalayas.

NOTE:- However, in the case of Kendriya Vidyalayas set up in the campuses of Public Sector Undertaking/~~Institution~~ where the sponsoring authority bears the entire expenditure, children of their employees will get over-riding priority in admissions followed by the general categories as enumerated above. After meeting the demand of the employees of the sponsoring Undertaking or Inst. of Higher Learning, Sangathan will admit children of other priority categories. Children coming on transfer from other Kendriya Vidyalayas will be automatically admitted.

No deviation from the aforesaid admission policy as approved by the Government of India will be made. The admissions to the proposed Kendriya Vidyalaya will not, therefore, be automatic. The students will be administered an admission test and will be accorded admission to the class for which they are found fit and eligible.

STAFF:- The entire staff will be appointed by the Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan on the scales of pay and terms and conditions prescribed from time to time by the Sangathan.

VIDYALAYA MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE:

The Vidyalaya Management Committee will be constituted in accordance with the pattern prescribed by the Sangathan as per proforma (Annexure VI(PS) attached).

AFFILIATION:- The school will get itself affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi at the appropriate time.

In the event of violation of the terms and conditions for running the Kendriya Vidyalaya by the sponsoring authority, the Sangathan will have the right to close down the Kendriya Vidyalaya and examine the distribution of assets and liabilities in consultation with the Government of India.

Further, aforesaid terms and conditions are subject to modifications in the light of the directive of Government of India/Board of Governors' decision taken from time to time.
